



WHEN CONSTRUCTION CREWS ARE WORKING ON COUNTY ROAD 43, THE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS. THIS RESTRICTION IS IN PLACE DUE TO INCREASED HAZARDS DURING ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION AND PILOT CAR OPERATIONS. AS AN ALTERNATE ROUTE TO ESTES PARK, CYCLISTS ARE ASKED TO INSTEAD TRAVEL ON US 34.

CREWS ARE TYPICALLY ON THE ROADWAY MONDAYS THROUGH SATURDAYS FROM 7 A.M. TO 6 P.M. THIS SCHEDULE IS WEATHER DEPENDENT AND SUBJECT TO CHANGE, SO ANYONE INTERESTED IN RIDING THEIR BIKE THROUGH THE AREA IS ENCOURAGED TO FIRST CHECK THE CURRENT WEEK'S WORK SCHEDULE ONLINE AT WWW.LCR43.COM.

WHEN CREWS ARE NOT ON THE ROADWAY, COUNTY ROAD 43 WILL BE OPEN TO PEOPLE ON BICYCLES. CYCLISTS ARE STILL ENCOURAGED TO USE ALTERNATE ROUTES. WHEN THE ROAD IS OPEN, RIDERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF ROUGH, UNEVEN ROAD SURFACES, STEEP SHOULDERS AND SECTIONS OF SINGLE-LANE ROADWAY THAT ARE CONTROLLED BY TIMED TRAFFIC SIGNALS.
